
Current News / Situation

- Templeton is in a state of emergency (16 MAR 2020); The Town Administrator (also the Incident Commander) has extended the closure of town offices until May 4th.
- Priorities in community: Personal Protective Equipment, Food Pantry (donations), Critical Staff

- The Alliance Health Long Term Care facility has sustained a significant amount of positive COVID-19 cases. The recent testing help from the Massachusetts National Guard has assisted in portraying a more accurate picture of the situation. The MA Department of Public Health, the Montachusett Public Health Network, and the Templeton Health Team are working together to assist the Alliance Health staff in reducing the surge in cases.
- COVID-19 symptoms of this infection may appear 2-14 days
 after exposure and include: Fever, Cough, and shortness of
 breath, and in severe cases, pneumonia (fluid in the lungs). Call
 your healthcare professional if you develop symptoms, and
 have been in close contact with a person known to have

At the request of Baldwinville Nursing Home, National Guard tested all residents and employees of BNH (Alliance Health) those tests were priority processed and results were received on Friday, April 17, 2020; prior to that testing, there were 15 positive cases.

With the spike in the total number of confirmed cases, the Board of Health felt it was in the best interest of the town residents to know that their hard work in following the protocols of handwashing, use of a masks and individuals able to stay home is working; the total set forth by the State reflects the total including Baldwinville Nursing Home.

- Town Hall: closed for public access until 4 May; use the website for transactions or call; Safety of citizens during any future elections being planned for, supplies ordered; <u>next BoS meeting</u> 4/22 @6:30pm (on-line);
- Board of Health; publishing revision of data report to follow updated state guidance; continual close coordination with Allied Health (Baldwinville Nursing)
- NRSD Facilities: closed for school session until 4 May; Central Office (978) 939-5661; on-line classroom learning in use; 1st wave of Chromebook distribution commenced (survey)
- Senior Center/COA: closed; minimally staffed; EMD, CERT, and Senior Services have enabled a targeted 'wellness call' program, about 100/week
- Food Pantry: open Tuesday 9-12am, Thursday 12-3pm and 5-7pm with specific instructions; Located in back of Senior Center; Donations (food and money) are still needed, checks may be made out to: Town of Templeton ("Food Pantry" in the memo); thank you to Narragansett Music Boosters for your help and donations!; our current demand is level from the last week
- Emergency Services: vestibules only; sign up for CodeRed on town website or text "templetonma" to 99411 or call (866) 939-0911;
- DPW: full operations; office closed to public; cemeteries are closed for new burials; playgrounds closed
