| Current News / Situation | Templeton is in a state of emergency (16 MAR 2020); The Town Administrator (also the Incident Commander) has extended the closure of town offices until May 4th; this is in line with the Governor's previous action. |

| | previous action. The Templeton Board of Health met via Zoom and YouTube livestream on Monday, April 13 th at 4pm. The board deliberated on the subject of reporting numbers of COVID19 statistics and heard public comment and questions. The board decided to maintain the practice of not reporting numbers publicly, citing patient stigma and privacy-related concerns. BoH is researching compromise statistics solution. On April 6th MRPC's Executive Director offered the MRPC's geographic information system (GIS) assets to the Montachusett Public Health Network. Specifically, the GIS staff will provide COVID-19 case data to the Network's Health Agents so that local officials and the medical community will be able to track the disease as its spreads through the population at the municipal level. No personal information will be published by the MRPC, therefore there will be no violation of the Federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). *Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others.* Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2. COVID-19 symptoms of this infection may appear 2-14 days after exposure and include: Fever, Cough, and shortness of breath, and in severe cases, pneumonia (fluid in the lungs). Call your healthcare |



The facility is permitted for 22 beds and has been inspected by TFD for safety. Priorities in community: Personal Protective Equipment, Food Pantry (donations), Critical Staff |
