## Current News / Situation

- Templeton is in a state of emergency (16 MAR 2020); The Town Administrator (also the Incident Commander IC) has extended the closure of town offices until May 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Deputy Incident Commander: MMA zoom conference today; MA has seen decrease in numbers in the last few days; awaiting guidance on when/how to conduct ATM from Lt. Governor (Karen Polito)
- Effective today, May 6, 2020, Governor Baker issued an Order requiring face masks or cloth face coverings in public places where social distancing is not possible. This applies to both indoor and outdoor spaces. Exceptions include children under the age of 2 and those unable to wear a mask or face covering due to a medical condition. Full details are outlined in the May 1 Order.
- BOH agents and their authorized agents will be able to enforce, may result in a fine of up
  to \$300 for any violations, the discretion is with the ticketing agency; Businesses may
  deny entry to patrons not wearing a face covering. BOH Meeting to discuss this is pending
- COVID-19 symptoms of this infection may appear 2-14 days after exposure and include: Fever, Cough, and shortness of breath, and in severe cases, pneumonia (fluid in the lungs). Call your healthcare professional if you develop symptoms, and have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19.


