As cases of COVID-19 continue to rise within our communities and the holiday gatherings ending, and in accordance with Governor Baker's winter advisory, the Templeton Board of Health Agent is requesting that *all persons wear a mask/face covering when conducting business in any of the town buildings* (including town hall, library, senior center, DPW, Police and Fire Stations) regardless of vaccination status.

While vaccination does prevent most hospitalizations and deaths due to COVID-19, it does not prevent transmission; wearing a mask/face covering will help to prevent transmission.

If you are interested, there are still vaccines available (including for boosters) at the local pharmacies.
