## Meetings for Residents and Property Owners

The Town of Templeton plans to submit a Community Development Block Grant application in early March to fund repair of School, Cottage, and Vernon Streets. The planned work includes:

- ❖ School Street - Drainage system upgrades as well as new sidewalks, curbs, street pavement. New water main under a separate contract.
- ❖ Cottage Street – New sidewalk, curb/berm, street pavement, graded for improved drainage.
- ❖ Vernon Street – New water main, berm, and street pavement, graded for improved drainage.

As a project area resident or property owner you are encouraged to attend one of the following meetings to provide input into the final design work.

To make this grant application successful it is critical that residents and property owners become involved in reviewing the plans for repair.
