Templeton has thirty active cases as of 12/17/2020; *we had four new positive cases added and two come off quarantine/isolation.* According to the state. The state reports that Templeton has 42 positive cases, the difference is due to lag time in reporting of persons coming off of quarantine and isolation, which we keep track of in office.
