How do you know if you are a close contact of someone with COVID-19?

- *You are a close contact of a COVID-19 positive person if you were within 6' of them while indoors for at least 15 minutes while they were symptomatic, or within the 48 hours before symptom onset.*
- *You are also a close contact if you were within 6' for at least 15 minutes of someone while indoors, who tested positive for COVID-19 in the 48 hours before their test was taken, or anytime in the 10 days after the test.*
- *According to the CDC guidance, individuals are less likely to be exposed to COVID-19 during outdoor activities, even without the use of face coverings.*
