FY19 Q1 PUBLIC SAFETY REPORT

Emergency Management

Emergency Management was quite busy in the 1st quarter. We applied for reimbursement from FEMA for a severe snow storm in March, gathering overtime and equipment costs from the Highway Department. This is an on-going process and we will be meeting with FEMA on 11/5 to get this process moving along. We also assisted Town Officials with the Local State of Emergency caused by the Stoney Bridge incident--once again, an on-going process to secure grants/funding to remedy the issue.

We received a \$2,500.00 grant from FEMA/Homeland Security for the CERT program with which we purchased a 5'x8' utility trailer to store/carry our sheltering equipment. This trailer is housed in the EOC.

We applied for and awarded a \$2,650.00 EMPG Grant. This money will be expended July 2019 on signage, traffic/parking control items and batteries for 8 of our Town hand-held radios.

Our volunteer CERT Program was active providing public safety services for the following activities:

- State Triathlon held at Lake Dennison
- Mac n' Cheese Festival
- (2) 5K Road races
- Arts and Crafts Festival
- Firefighter Re-Hab (Mutual Aid) Royalston (Pete and Henry's Restaurant)
- Motorpalooza
- Stoney Bridge Incident

Sgt. Flis, Templeton Police Department, gave the CERT members a class on the Alice System used at our schools. This was followed by a meeting with the School Resource Officer to begin putting Emergency Management and CERT into the Emergency Reaction Plans for the Schools, assisting wherever needs arise.

Rich Curtis (EMD) also met with the TPD, SRO, Head of Maintenance, to have CERT assist them during Homecoming Activities at the school on 10/6/18.

Starting July 1st, Emergency Management began utilizing CodeRed for it's volunteer call-out system.

Fire Department

The Templeton Fire Department for the first quarter of FY 19 handled 168 emergency calls of which:

- 20 were motor vehicle accidents,
- 15 accidental fire alarms,
- 2 mutual aid to other towns,
- 129 ambulance calls,
- 1 roadside hazard, and
- 1 assist to Highway at Stone Bridge Rd.

We did 55 residential inspections for smoke and carbon monoxide detectors for home sales, propane tank inspections, and home heating oil/ heating systems.

We continued training on the new fire reporting system with implementation set for January of 2019.

Hiring of our new full time firefighter/ paramedics was completed.

Our new Engine that was approved at annual town meeting has been ordered and should be here in June or July.

Police Department

The 1st Quarter was a busy three months for the police department as we tried to settle into the Baldwinville Fire Station as construction on the police station project started.

Our original dispatch center plan was revamped by the State 911 Department and we now have two fully functional dispatch stations.

A technical issue prohibited our ability to process LTCs with the State for approximately a month, but was later resolved by numerous hours of trouble shooting various issues.

Unit 27 sustained damage as a result of responding to a call for service. The damage was repaired by the property owners insurance at no cost to the Town.

The police station project is progressing nicely and is currently ahead of schedule for final completion.
