Templeton has eighteen active cases as of 12/11/2020; although it appears our numbers have stayed the same, we had four new cases and four case came off after proper quarantine/isolation. According to the state, Templeton is in a state of yellow, there is lag time with reporting due to the volume of testing and positive cases, currently the state is reporting that Templeton has 28 cases.
