

TERMINATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Governor of Massachusetts has determined, that the State of Emergency, put in place on March 10, 2020 to facilitate and expedite the use of Commonwealth resources and deployment of federal and interstate resources to protect persons from the impacts of the spread of COVID-19, will end on June 15, 2021.

<u>WHEREAS</u>, businesses in Templeton can now run at full capacity, the mandate of wearing masks has been eased – leaving the wearing of masks up to businesses and individuals, and as of June 1, 2021 Town offices are now open for in-person business.

<u>WHEREAS</u>, Templeton's Incident Command Team for the COVID-19 emergency, (comprised of the Select Board Chair, Town Administrator, Board of Health Agent, and the Emergency Management Director), agree that the current State of Emergency is no longer necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, we, the Select Board for the Town of Templeton, Massachusetts, **HEREBY TERMINATE THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN TEMPLETON** that was put into effect on March 16, 2020 at 18:00 hours, **EFFECTIVE JUNE 15, 2021** TO COINCIDE WITH THE GOVERNOR'S state of emergency termination for the State.
