To either of the Constables of the Town of Templeton, in said County.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the several precincts of the Town of Templeton, County of Worcester, qualified to vote in Town elections to meet in their respective precincts at the places designated and appointed by the Selectmen, to wit:

PRECINCT A - FIRST CHURCH OF TEMPLETON

PRECINCT B - BALDWINVILLE AMERICAN LEGION

On Monday, the twenty-second day of January next, from 11:00 o'clock A.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M. to bring their votes to the Election Officers on one ballot as follows:

1. Shall the Town of Templeton be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition 2 1/2, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bond issue in order to fully design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovations at the Narragansett Regional High School and the 550 student capacity addition thereto. The cost of the debt exclusion for the renovation and addition to the existing structure at 464 Baldwinville Road, Templeton would be \$20,603.50. (*\$20,603, 250.00*)
