On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted, pursuant to M.G.L.c. 41, s.1B, to have its elected Collector of Taxes become an appointed Collector of Taxes of the Town to be appointed by the Board of Selectmen. **Passed** (*a*) 7:14

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of Four Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars (\$4,600.00) from the Recreation Committee Salaries

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer the sum of Four Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars **(\$4,600.00)** from the Recreation

Account to the Recreation Committee Expense Account, or to take any

Committee Salaries Account to the Recreation Committee Expense Account. Passed Unanimously @ 7:15

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of financing the following Water Pollution Abatement Facility Projects: repair, replacement and/or upgrade of septic systems, pursuant to agreements with Board of Health and residential property owners, including without limitation all costs thereof as defined in Section 1 of Chapter 29C of the General Laws; to determine whether this appropriation shall be raised by borrowing from the Massachusetts Water Pollution Abatement Trust or otherwise, or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to appropriate the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) for the purpose of financing the following Water Pollution Abatement Facility Projects: repair, replacement and/or upgrade of septic systems, pursuant to agreements with the Board of Health and residential property owners, including without limitation all costs thereof as defined in Section 1 of Chapter 29C of the General Laws; that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen is authorized to borrow Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) and issue bonds or notes therefore under Chapter 44, Chapter 111, s.127B1/2 and/or Chapter 29C of the General Laws, or any other enabling authority; that project and financing costs shall be repaid by the property owners, in accordance with those agreements, but such bonds or notes shall be general obligations of the Town; that the Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Selectmen is authorized to borrow all or a portion of such amount from the Massachusetts Water Pollution Abatement Trust established pursuant to Chapter 29C and in connection therewith to enter into a loan agreement and/or security agreement with the Trust and otherwise contract with the Trust and the Department of Environmental Protection with respect to such loan and for any federal or state aid available for the projects or the financing thereof; and that the Board of Selectmen, Board of Public Works or other appropriate local body or official is authorized to enter into a project regulatory agreement with the Department of Environmental Protection, to expend all funds available for the projects and to take any other action necessary to carry out the projects.

Passed Unanimously @ 7:24

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds or otherwise provide for the lease and/or purchase of a police cruiser to include equipment, or to take any other action relative thereto.

On a motion duly made and seconded the Town voted to transfer from the Stabilization Account the sum of Twenty-Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-Three Collars (\$27,963.00) for the purchase of a police cruiser to include a 100,000 miles warranty and equipment. Passed Unanimously @ 7:27
