^{*}Please note that no more than 2 voters will be allowed in Town Hall to vote early at all times.

Public Access to Town Hall is Only for Early Voting!

There will be two voting stations set up in the Room 1 conference area.

Voters will be required to have a face covering on upon entering the building (a supply face masks will be on hand for those that come without); hand sanitizer will be offered, and name and phone number will be recorded for possible contact tracing.

Once done voting and exiting the area, town representatives will clean touched areas with a bleach solution or approved cleaning solution prior to the next voter(s) coming in (table, chair armrests, door knobs, etc...); pens/pencils used will be put aside for later disinfecting (a new pen/pencil will be provided to each voter for use).

As the voter leaves, they will once again be offered hand sanitizer and doors will be cleaned upon exit.

Upon the conclusion of each day's voting, the room will be cleaned and a sanitizing mist will be sprayed after business hours.

Vote Early – By Mail

Voting by mail is available to all voters for all elections in 2020.

To vote by mail, all you need to do is:

- 1. Complete a Vote by Mail Application;
- 2. **Deliver** your application to the Town Clerk's office;
- 3. **Vote** when your ballot arrives;
- 4. **Return** your ballot.

Applications must reach our office by **August 26** for the State Primary.
