The Station Project – we have a few issues we a still working on such as cruiser coverage, new generator and rear fence. We have completed about half of the security upgrades.

We had a few officers leave our department due to the Towns' financial uncertainty caused by the school districts' budget request. However, we have been able to rehire two of the positions and hope to work towards filling an additional position once the FY20 budget is finalized

During this quarter, Emergency Management was involved in the following;

I worked with Kelli P., Cheryl R. and Holly Y. to obtain necessary documentation for 2 grant reimbursement packages. Once all documentation was gathered, I submitted the 2018 EMPG (\$2,644.45) and the 2018 EMPG-Competitive (\$9,999.97) grant reimbursements. The Town should receive the reimbursements soon.

I submitted an application for a competitive Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), for \$2,900.00. Should this grant be approved, spending on equipment will begin after July 1, 2020.

I discussed Ethics (Conflict of Interest) and Opening Meeting Law mandatory training requirements with Adam L., Carter T., Carol H., and Holly Y., via phone and emails.

Sent MEMA Situational Reports to Selectmen, Carter T., and Adam L. as necessary for upcoming severe weather. I hosted conference calls, (at Adam L. request), on 12/1/19 and 12/29/19 for storm preparedness with the following department heads invited: Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works, EMD, Deputy EMD, COA, Supt of Schools, BOH, Light and Water, Adam L. and Carter T. I monitored both of these storm events through computer (WebEOC-MEMA) and phone. Mike Dickson was instrumental in getting me updates every few hours, and preparing the EOC should it be needed.

Worked on and submitted, the Emergency Management 2021 Budget request.

The Town's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) has been active in the following:

1. CERT regular monthly meetings (October, November and December).
2. Assisted Templeton Police with NRHS Homecoming event.
3. Halloween – Templeton Center road crossings
4. Jack Frost Festival / Parade
5. Assisted Fire Department with firefighter re-hab at a structure fire on Bridge Street.
6. Prepped EOC for severe winter storms.
7. Re-organization of EOC.
