RFP 1 for Digital Lab partnerships

The Town of Templeton seeks a partnership or partnerships in the non-profit or profit-based sectors for Templeton Community Television (TCTV). Partners will enter into co-management and possible fiduciary agreements with TCTV.

This RFP seeks partners in developing a regional Digital Lab to provide digital and media literacy services, high-tech workforce development programs, and a feeder system for community and other media.

This RFP is open to:

- Non-profit or for-profit businesses
- Higher education institutions
- Financial and financial management concerns
- Legal sector
- Other related entities

Potential partners may submit mutually beneficial business and marketing proposals for:

- Providing work and studio space for TCTV, the Digital Lab and Montachusett.TV.
- Primary partner will have fiduciary responsibilities for Montachusett.TV website: collecting and processing electronic fees, accounting and providing funding to TCTV as required by agreement.
- Business planning assistance and possible formation of the Digital Lab as a 501c3 charity as an educational foundation.
- Partner(s) will assist TCTV with the development and management of a Digital Lab, Montachusett.TV and TCTV marketing and promotions.
- Partner(s) will work together to secure operational and capital grants for the Digital Lab and Montachusett.TV staffing and operation.
- Partners will share marketing lists and other resources as outlined in an agreement such as a Memorandum of Understanding.

The Town of Templeton seeks partnerships to work with Templeton Community Television (TCTV) to develop and promote the regional Montachusett.TV website.

Montachusett.TV partners will get in on the ground floor of a regional website targeted at a regular audience of 250,000+ throughout North Central Mass., from Littleton to Orange.

Montachusett.TV provides information on arts, culture and community events throughout the Montachusett Region, and features a business platform to build resilience among area businesses.

Despite funding challenges, arts and culture have been identified as crucial in building community spirit, engagement, economic development, and overall community health and resilience.

A thriving arts and culture scene in our region can be supported by businesses that can benefit from a regional digital marketing and business platform in Montachusett.TV.
