

DPW Department - Highway and Buildings and Grounds Q4 FY2020 Report

<u>Buildings and Grounds</u> – Throughout the Covid-19 outbreak the Cemetery and Highway division continued to work 40 hours using the precautions established by the Board of Health. Spring cleanup of all town buildings and cemeteries was done. A heavy rain and windstorm caused some damage at Pine Grove cemetery 2 large pine trees came down damaging a fence and a couple of tomb stones. Repairs to the fence and tomb stones will be done. Expansion in Pine Grove cemetery was discussed and approved and will be done during the summer months.

<u>Highway</u> –Assistance was given to the Cemetery department in removing debris in an old dumping area and enhancing the appearance of the cemetery. Many neighborhoods took the time to pick up roadside trash and placed it on the roadside for pick-up. We appreciate and say Thank you for the involvement in this project. An old retired Sidewalk plow was resurrected and added to the front of the highway barn lawn to represent the Highway barn location. Road side sweeping is complete, continued efforts to clean catch basins and start road side mowing.
