INVITATION TO BID

The Town of Templeton, Massachusetts is seeking an experienced licensed contractor with commercial experience to install two bituminous all-weather Tennis & Pickleball Courts at Gilman-Waite in Baldwinville, MA. The successful Contractor will provide all of their own equipment including but not limited to; working tools of the trade and all other related tools necessary to complete the project. The contractor shall be fully licensed and insured at the Town's standard rates. The Contractor is responsible to pull all required permits with all local and state authorities. Permit fees imposed by the Town of Templeton will be waived.

Bid specifications are available at the Select Board's Office, 160 Patriots Rd, Rm. 6, P.O. Box 620, Templeton MA 01438, M – Th., 7.30 am – 4:30 pm. Sealed bids shall be accepted at the Select Board's Office, 160 Patriots Rd, Rm. 6, P.O. Box 620, Templeton MA 01438 until **Wednesday**, **August 30, 2023, at 2:00 p.m.** at which time they shall be publicly opened in the Town Hall conference room.

Bid submissions must be all inclusive of material, labor, and equipment, except where noted. No extra charges allowed; any change orders must be preapproved by both parties.

All Wage Rates will comply with those established by the Commonwealth Department of Labor and Industries M.G. L. Chapter 140, Sections 26-27G. A copy of the current prevailing wages is attached. Affidavit of OSHA Compliance and an insurance certificate will be required from the successful submitter.

Bid Submission Process:

Final bids must be received by 2:00 pm on Wednesday, August 30, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., and shall be submitted as follows: Sealed bids (*including pages 7-9 of this form*) shall be submitted either by <u>hand delivery to the Town Administrator's Office, Town Hall, Rm. 6, 160 Patriots Road, East Templeton, MA, 01438, or mailed to:</u>

Bids will be time stamped as they are received. The Town's time stamp shall be controlling. Bids received by the Town after the Submission Deadline will be deemed non-responsive and will be rejected. Telecopied or electronically mailed (e-mailed) bids will be deemed non-responsive and rejected regardless of the date received. Bidders are cautioned to hand deliver their bids. Any bid delivered late in person will be refused; if delivered late by mail, it will be returned to its respective sender. If a bid is left in the drop box, *it will automatically be rejected*.

Timely bids will be opened at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, August 30, 2023, at 2:00 p.m., in the conference room at 160 Patriots Road, East Templeton, MA, 01438, and at that time only the names of bidders and total amount of each bid will be read.

All sealed bids must be marked "Two bituminous all-weather Tennis & Pickleball Courts at Gilman-Waite". The Town reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive informalities if deemed in the Town's best interest to do so. MBE/WBE firms encouraged to apply.

The Town will not accept any information or materials submitted after the Submission Deadline unless such information or materials are provided in response to the Town's written request for such information or materials. Bids shall be unconditional. Prior to the Submission Deadline, bidders may correct, modify or withdraw a bid by written notice to the Town's contact person. Prior to opening the bids, any person(s) needing to make changes, correct, modify, or withdraw their bid, which has already been submitted, must submit a request in writing in order to receive their bid. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 180 days after the date set for the opening thereof. After the opening of bids, a bidder may not correct or modify its bid in any manner unless in response to a written request by the Town in its sole discretion. These submission requirements will be strictly enforced. The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informalities, to advertise for new bids, and to award one or more contracts, wholly or in part, as may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Town. **The Templeton Select Board is the awarding authority.**

The Select Board, or their designee, will make a contract award for the installation of two bituminous all-weather Tennis & Pickleball Courts at Gilman-Waite Field to the responsible and responsive bidder (as determined by the Town) with the lowest price. Bid submissions must be all inclusive of material, labor, and equipment, except where noted. No extra charges will be allowed, any change orders must be pre-approved by both parties. The Town reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids if it is in the Town's best interest to do so. Bid proposals and prices shall stand as submitted for a period of 45 business days or until the contract is executed. The selection of the supplier shall be made without regard to race, color, sex, age, religion, political affiliation, or national origin. The successful bidder shall be required to enter into a contract with the Town.

The successful bidder will provide a payment bond and a performance bond each in the amount of 100% of the value of the total bid, and a certificate of insurance with coverages as outlined below WITHIN 10 DAYS OF BEING NOTIFIED VIA EMAIL THAT THEY ARE THE WINNING BIDDER. If the payment bond and a current certificate of insurance evidencing the required insurance is not submitted to the Town within the 10-day period after email notification, the bid will be automatically awarded to the second highest qualified bidder. The certificate of insurance shall be provided *prior* to the commencement of work and shall remain in force during the term of the contract.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

a. Prior to commencing work, and throughout the term of this Contract, Agreement, Permit or License, the Town property user shall obtain, and maintain, in the limits and under the conditions set forth below, insurance coverage for the following types and levels of coverage:

i. Workers Compensation: Statutory

ii. Automobile and Equipment: \$1 Million/\$1 Millioniii. Property Damage: \$1 Million/\$2 Millioniv. General Liability: \$1 Million/\$2 Million

b. The Town of Templeton shall be named as certificate holder. The name and address in the 'certificate holder' box shall be listed as follows:

- c. The Town of Templeton and its' officers, employees and agents shall be named as an additional insured.
- d. The Town shall be notified no earlier than thirty (30) days before any such policy is cancelled, altered, or materially changed. (Either via email to hyoung@templetonma.gov or via first class mail at the address listed in b.).

Site Inspection Meeting

A site inspection will be held on Tuesday, August 15, 2023, at 8 a.m. at the existing tennis courts at Gilman-Waite Field in Baldwinville, MA. The inspection will allow prospective contractors to familiarize themselves with all conditions that may affect the performance and cost of the contract. In order to accommodate all individuals, please call ahead on or before Monday, August 14, 2023, at 4 p.m. to confirm participation in the site inspection by contacting Holly Young at 978-894-2762. **Failure to become familiarized with all conditions shall not constitute a basis for subsequent contract change orders.**

Scope of Work Outline

Note: This is a general outline of the work to be performed. It is not intended to be an all-inclusive list of requirements. Other work may need to be performed in addition to the outlined work, and it is the responsibility of the general contractor to include the complete scope of work in their bid submission. Department of Public Services will be taking down the fencing for access.

The general scope of work is as follows:

Furnish all labor, material and equipment to pulverize and remove and replace 1,152 SY of tennis courts, furnish and apply a four coat acrylic surface system to bituminous concrete surface as outlined below:

- 1. Reclaim or remove existing bituminous concrete tennis courts and remove the existing net posts.
- 2. Remove any excess material from the site.
- 3. Fine grade and compact.
- 4. Furnish, spread and roll 1.5" of bituminous concrete binder course.
- 5. Install two sets of steel net post sleeves and center anchors (fence posts should be in at this time).
- 6. Furnish, spread and roll 1.5" of bituminous concrete top.
- 7. Sweep and air clean to be surfaced.
- 8. Apply two coats of acrylic resurfacer mixed 5-10 pounds of 50-60 mesh silica sand per gallon of resurfacer and applied at a rate of .07 to .10 gallon per square yard.
- 9. Apply two coats of latexite textured surface at a rate of approximately .05 gallon/SY per coat.
- 10. Install two sets of new douglas tennis posts and nets.
- 11. Layout, mask, and stripe two tennis and two pickleball playing lines with a paintbrush using 100% acrylic textured line paint.
- 12. Remove masking tape and clean up general work area.

The work site will be at the current tennis court. See photo below:

- The wage rates will remain in effect for the duration of the project, except in the case of multi-year public construction projects. For construction projects lasting longer than one year, awarding authorities must request an updated wage schedule no later than two weeks before the anniversary of the date the contract was executed by the awarding authority and the general contractor. For multi-year CM AT RISK projects, the awarding authority must request an annual update no later than two weeks before the anniversary date, determined as the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the execution date of the first amendment to permit procurement of construction services. The annual update requirement is not applicable to 27F "rental of equipment" contracts. The updated wage schedule must be provided to all contractors, including general and sub-contractors, working on the construction project.
- This wage schedule applies only to the specific project referenced at the top of this page and uniquely identified by the "Wage Request Number" on all pages of this schedule.
- An Awarding Authority must request an updated wage schedule if it has not opened bids or selected a contractor within 90 days of the date of issuance of the wage schedule. For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or a sub-contractor.
- Apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS).
 Apprentices must keep their apprentice identification card on their persons during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DAS regardless of whether they are registered with another federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the journeyworker's rate.
- Every contractor or subcontractor working on the construction project must submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. For a sample payroll reporting form go to http://www.mass.gov/dols/pw.
- Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- Contractors must obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities. Failure of a contractor or subcontractor to pay the prevailing wage rates listed on the wage schedule to all employees who perform construction work on the project is a violation of the law and subjects the contractor or subcontractor to civil and criminal penalties.
- Employees not receiving the prevailing wage rate set forth on the wage schedule may file a complaint with the Fair Labor Division of the office of the Attorney General at (617) 727-3465.
