

Weekly: Received my official designation as a Massachusetts Certified Public Purchasing Official (MCPPO) Designation from the Inspector General's office. Had a meeting with Don Jacobs to go over the Performance Management Program implementation. Holly and Jackie held interviews for the Veterans Service position. Held the bid opening on August 3rd for the Senior Center Roof project with Larochelle Construction, Inc. of South Hadley, MA, being the apparent lowest bidder. Held the bid opening on August 4th for the Weatherization work for Town Hall, Boynton Public Library, Baldwinville Fire Station, and Cemetery Garage with DCS, LLC of Amherst, MA, being the apparent lowest bidder. Both of these projects will be going to the Select Board for action.
